**APPLICATION FOR POSITION ON YOUNG LAWYERS SUBCOMMITTEE ON THE COUNCIL OF THE
INSURANCE LAW SECTION – TERM EXPIRING 2027**

The Council of the Insurance Law Section of the State Bar of Texas is looking for four (4) young lawyers who meet the below criteria to serve on the Young Lawyer Subcommittee of the Insurance Council of the Insurance Law Section. The four young lawyers will serve a two-year term (expiring 2027), along with the four young lawyers currently serving on the Young Lawyer Subcommittee with terms expiring in 2026.

Minimum criteria:

1. Been practicing ten (10) years or fewer ***or*** be under the age of 40.
2. Are a member of the Insurance Section of the State Bar of Texas. *[If you're not a member: join here: <https://www.insurancelawsection.org/product/insurance-law-section-member-dues/> Dues are \$40.00 for a June 1-May 31 membership; if licensed two (2) years or less, the fee is waived with the submission of the printed member application available for download at the link above.]*
3. Can commit to: (a) help organize the Insurance Law 101 CLE at the Advanced Insurance Law Course in June; (b) help organize two young lawyer networking events a year; (c) participate in case summaries for the Insurance Section website; and (d) possibly attend four or five in-person Council meetings a year (expenses reimbursed by the Section).

Considerations, but not requirements:

1. Have meaningfully committed time or contributed to other organizations/activities outside of your normal firm/job responsibilities.
2. Have demonstrated leadership in other, similar activities.
3. Contributes to the diversity of the council as to practice area (policy holder v. carrier practice), regional diversity, in addition to the traditional diversity considerations.
